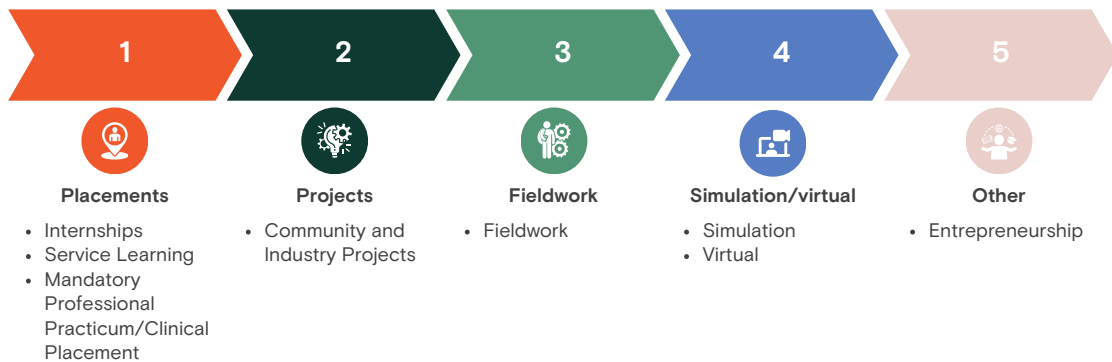




Work-integrated Learning (WIL) Questions in Subject Outlines 2024

Work-integrated Learning (WIL) is the integration of theory and the authentic, meaningful practice of work with an industry or community partner embedded within the curriculum and related to student’s study, career development, and citizenship.

- Whether there are any other instances in your subject involving students engaging with Industry Partners? (eg. interviewing Industry Partners for assessment)
- Whether Industry Partners are involved in the subject delivery
