Excellence in teaching

OER can enable innovative learning and teaching, fostering local identity and benefiting equity cohorts

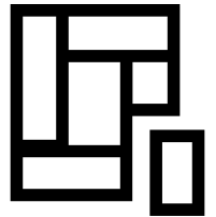


Make education accessible

Reduce cost barriers to equitable learning and improve student retention rates.

Flexible, adaptable resources

Customise locally relevant content, which can be easily updated.



Meaningful innovation and engagement

New ways of challenging students via co-creation. Teachers are embedded in the text; students can be participatory partners.

Expanded access to learning

Anyone can access OER at any time, and they can access the material repeatedly in their workplaces and communities



Finding OER

Lots of places to discover OER!

Tips for searching:

- Start broad and use filters to narrow down
- Always check the licensing conditions
- Keep a list of what you found and where
- Evaluate the OER before deciding to adopt or adapt it.





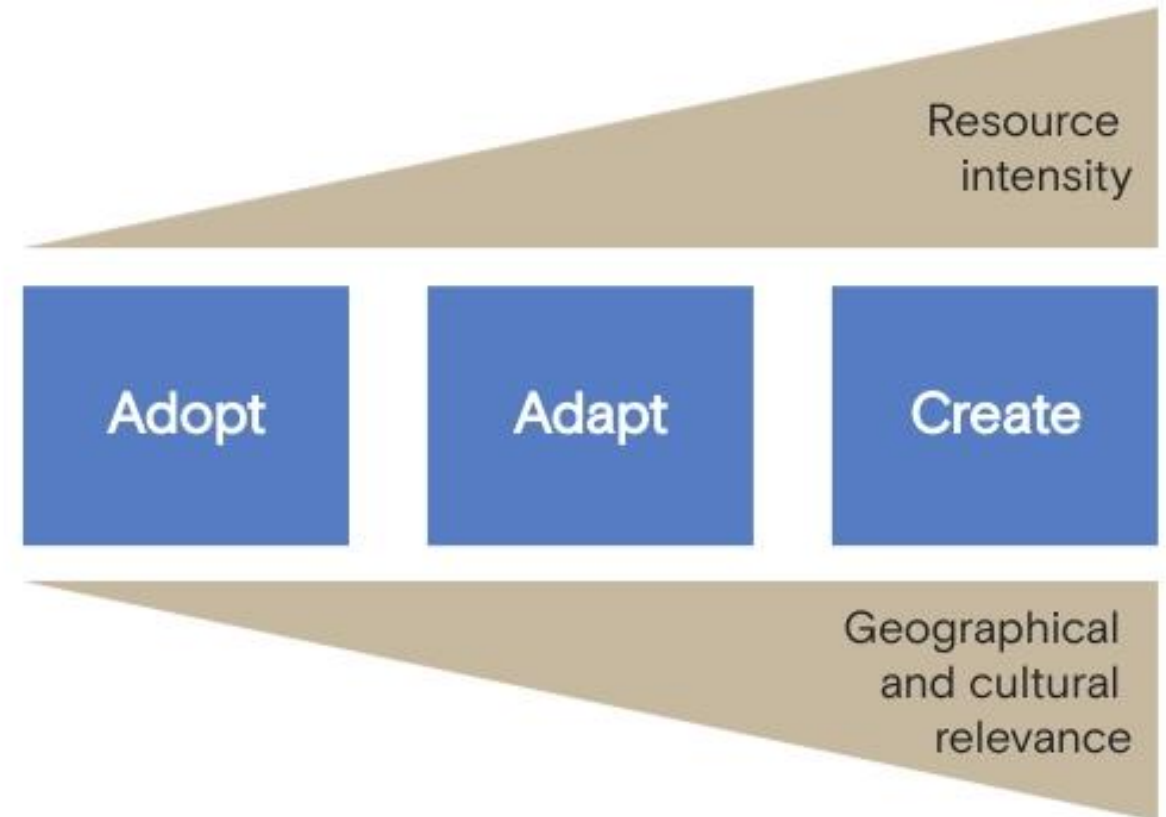
Adopting, adapting and creating
